

Over eight in ten Europeans support a common defence and security policy among EU Member States






Additionally, over eight in ten agree that **co-operation in defence matters at EU level should be increased...**




...while almost three quarters say more money should be spent on defence in the EU



Over eight in ten think that by standing against the Russian invasion in Ukraine, **the EU is defending European values**






A majority of Europeans are satisfied with the response to the Russian invasion in Ukraine by...




At least seven in ten agree with all of the actions
