InSign: Advancing Inclusive Education Through International Sign

InSign

InSign is a three-year international research project co-funded by the European Union (Erasmus+). The aim of the project is to create an innovative infrastructure to promote communication between deaf and non-deaf people, as well as between deaf students from different countries using International Sign Language (ISL).

Objectives

- ✓ An automatic translator from various European languages to International Sign Language via a 3D avatar.
- ✓ A certified course on International Sign Language and a MOOC (Massive Open Online Course) aimed at deaf and non-deaf people who want to learn a simple sign language.
- ✓ A book (with ISBN) to be published in five European languages describing the main aspects of International Sign Language as a globalised lingua franca.
